What Is a Citizen Memorandum?

A **Citizen Memorandum** is a formal written notice from the people to the government.

It places concerns and objections into the public record, so officials cannot claim they did not know.

Why Is This Strong?

A Citizen Memorandum:

- Creates official notice
- Documents consent or non-consent
- Creates accountability

Why This Matters Now

The memorandum addresses parental rights, emergency powers, and the loss of checks and balances.

These issues affect families, kupuna, farmers, and future generations.

If people do nothing, these powers become permanent.

This Is the Start of Change

Change starts when citizens go on the record.

One signature creates notice.

Many signatures create pressure.

Enough signatures create change.
